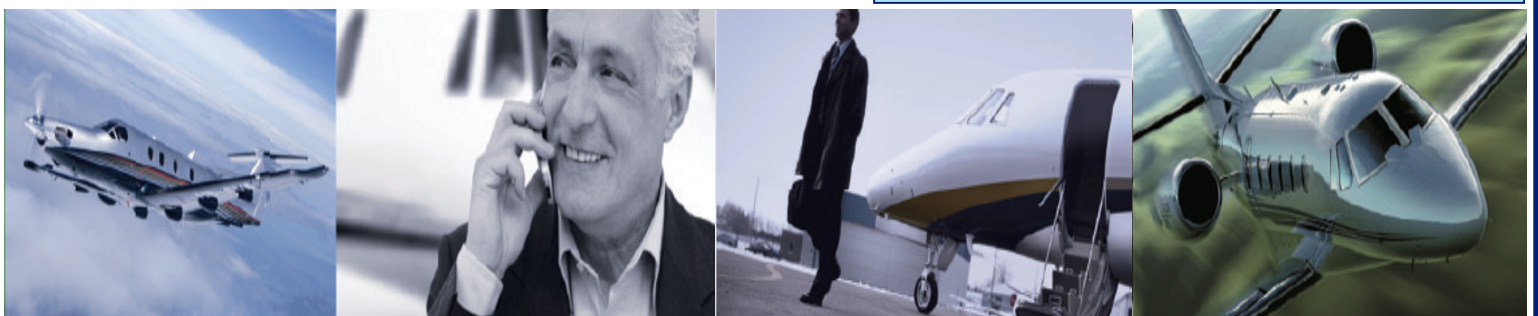
AirSprint Value #1: Safety - without Compromise

Our clients have put their trust in us to fly and safeguard the people that are most important in their lives. We take that trust very seriously.

Aviation is heavily regulated due to the risks inherent to flying. Let's face it, in our industry any sort of lapse in following Safety regulations has potential for catastrophic consequences. Regulations serve as guidelines, but the decisions that our pilots make every day ultimately ensure the safety of our passengers and aircraft. The effects that weather patterns, visibility, and wind speed or direction have upon an aircraft are always carefully evaluated. AirSprint pilots, when faced with a decision, are trained to always err on the side of caution in order to ensure that human safety is the priority.

AirSprint's aircraft inspection procedures are also critical. Our maintenance requirements are more stringent and inspections occur more frequently than is mandated by regulation.

AirSprint's culture of safety doesn't begin and end at the aircraft door, but extends right across our organization. A majority of AirSprint employees, even some whose roles are not directly related to flying, attend Safety training courses and regularly pass Safety examinations. If it seems like we may be overly cautious at times, please keep in mind our number one value; the safety of your family and ours is too valuable to do anything less.

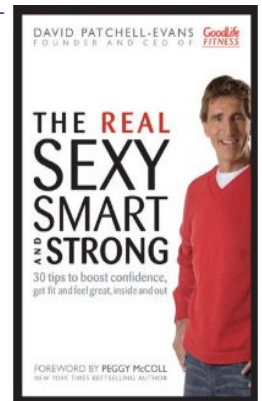
